

We specialize in occupational, physical, and speech-language pathology services that utilize the movement of the horse (hippotherapy) as one treatment tool used during therapy sessions. Therapists will determine if the use of the horse's movement is safe, appropriate, and beneficial. The horse provides multidimensional movement and sensory experiences, and our therapists use it to challenge a patient's balance, strength, coordination, motor control, sensory processing, speech and communication, and more.



Our therapists also have clinic spaces that give them access to treatment tools and strategies in order to develop an individualized plan of care for each patient. Clinic spaces come equipped with therapy tools such as a suspended swing, a partial weight bearing treadmill system, and a variety of other therapy equipment.

## Occupational Therapy

Our occupational therapists (OTs) work with patients to improve fine motor skills and activities of daily living. Our areas of specialty include sensory processing and regulation, organization of behavior, play development, self-help skills, motor planning, hand/eye coordination, muscle strengthening, and postural control.

## Physical Therapy

Our physical therapists (PTs) work with patients to improve gross motor skills and promote functional independence in the home, school, and community environments. Physical therapy focuses on addressing areas of range of motion, strength, safety awareness, balance, mobility, coordination, motor control, motor planning, endurance, and all aspects of movement.

## Speech-Language Therapy

Our speech-language pathologists (SLPs) work with patients and their families on various aspects of communication such as receptive and expressive language, alternative and augmentative communication (AAC), articulation and phonology, fluency, and social skills.

## Getting Started and Fees



To get started, fill out the Therapy Services Intake Paperwork provided on our website under the Services tab. A physician's prescription for therapy is required.
